Voter Registration Deadline for the 2024 Primary Election

Tammy Jones, Supervisor of Elections for Levy County, reminds voters that Monday, July 22nd is the last day to register to vote or to change political party affiliation for the August 20th Primary Election. "I would like to encourage all eligible Levy County residents who wish to participate in the upcoming Primary Election to register or update their information now. Voters have several options when registering to vote."

Voters may register or change their political party using any of the following methods:

- Online at www.votelevy.gov. Application must be completed by 11:59 p.m. on July 22nd.
- Mail a voter registration for to 421 South Court Street, Bronson, FL 32621. Must be postmarked by July 22nd.
- Visit the Levy County Supervisor of Elections Office at 421 South Court Street, Bronson, FL 32621 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Florida is a closed primary state, meaning that only voters registered with a political party can vote for that party's candidate in partisan races. However, all voters can cast a ballot during the Primary Election. There will be five Universal Primary Contests on the Primary Election ballot. Sheriff, Property Appraiser, Superintendent of Schools, County Commissioner, District 1, and County Commissioner, District 5. All voters, regardless of party affiliation may vote in a Universal Primary Contest. School Board, District 4 can also be found on every voters ballot due to being considered a nonpartisan race. "Many of the local races will be decided in the Primary Election, so voters who do not vote in the Primary will miss their chance to vote in these very important local contests," said Supervisor Jones.

Voters can view their current voter registration information, including party affiliation, by visiting www.votelevy.gov and clicking the "Check My Voter Status" button.
